

Points to be observed for the EXPORT of organic products from Third Countries into the European Community:

- In advance of each export consignment you have to apply at ABG for issuing an "Import Certificate". Please, request the application form per e-mail from b.wolf@abg.at and return the completed form to the same e-mail address.
- Your customer in the EC has to have a valid import authorization for the corresponding products in case of an import according to EC Regulation 1235/2008. The number of the relevant import authorization has to be announced to ABG.
- Additionally to the application form, accompanying papers of the corresponding consignment have to be sent to ABG per email (b.wolf@abg.at) or fax (++43/2262/672213 DD 33).
- Only in case the inspection of the submitted documents proved positive, the "Import certificate" will be issued for the consignment in question. Subsequently, the certificate will be delivered by post (if necessary also by express service) either to you or to any other address, which has been announced by you. On request we will send you and your customer, respectively, the scanned document for the announcement of the import at the relevant authority.

!ATTENTION! The **original** import certificate has to accompany the consignment at time of clearance. Hence, please apply for it at ABG in time. Normally, import certificates may be issued within a working day.

We will charge you for the import certificate and the porto (see: Fees International).
